



FS2Crew: Default Cessna 172 FSX Edition

- Flight1 172 FSX Merge -

Requirements: Flight1 172 FSX with panel.cfgs dated:
Thursday, November 18, 2004 at 19:50 FSPS Build:15838

Instructions:

1. We need to update two Flight1 172 FSX panel.cfg files:

The two panel.cfg files are located here:

Microsoft Flight Simulator X\SimObjects\Airplanes\F1_Cessna_172\panel\paneloptions

They are named: Panel_High_Res and Panel_Low_Res

2. Using Notepad, open both panel.cfg files and check that the Build is numbered 15838. Flight1 may update the 172 at some point in the future. This merge is only guaranteed to work with Build 15838.

If the Build is okay, make a backup of the two original Flight1 panel.cfg files.

3. Copy the two FS2Crew modified panel.cfg files located in this package over the original Flight 172 FSX panel.cfg files that you just backed up.
4. Run the Flight1 FSX 172 "Config Manager" and click "SAVE SETTINGS", then exit the Config Manager.

The modified FS2Crew panel.cfg will then become the main panel.cfg that gets loaded the next time you load the Flight1 172.

*The Flight1 172 Config Manager is located via Start – All Programs – Flight1 Software – Skyhawk 172R FSX.

Notes:

1. Usage is exactly the same as the default FSX 172 Edition of FS2Crew. There is however ONE BIG CHANGE:

The hidden click spot used to open/close the Main Selector panel in the 2D and VC cockpit is now located over the Aircraft Registration placard.



2. Important: Do not forget that the 172 must load using the 2D cockpit (not the VC) by default, or you may get a crash. Make sure the appropriate option is checked in the FSX menu.
